Treasurer's Report: Deposits totaled \$40,486.32; Checks written totaled \$57,143.08; bank balance as of 04/30/08 \$77,169.05

VP Finance: Tom reported General Fund Checking is \$46,752.90, and Student Accounts \$30,416.15.

Contributing Members: Joan reported that we need to decide on a new decal to use as a thank you for contributing members. We have about 40 left. Holy Cow quoted 90 cents apiece.

Fundraising: For next year we need co-chairs for Fannie May, Spirit Sales, Magazine Sales and Plant Sales. Fundraising letter to Brayer by May 16th in order to be included in the all school mailing.

Spirit Wear: Felt that the new design was a big hit this year with the students and families. Tutor shirts did not sell at all; we may think of donating these or else sell at reduced cost. Each year we donate to St. Scholastica in Woodridge a small box containing about 10-20 items for their auction.

Market Day: We have a new rep. Sara Lee will no longer be working with Market Day.

Fannie May: We have candy and for all three banquets and a \$50 gift certificate for the band banquet for their raffle.

Magazine Sale: Sales are still coming in and will have the final numbers at the next meeting.

Flower Sale: Went well and we had lots of helper early in the morning. To date we have \$4,898 income, \$1,500 to student accounts leaving \$3,368 net profit to Boosters. Will try to sell remaining plants at upcoming concert on Thursday. Joe Rush asked for a spreadsheet to be emailed to him. As of today's date there will be no further changes to students' accounts for the remainder of this school year with regard to fundraising. Need to make it clear to the students next year that their portion for their accounts is 30% of the total profit not the total sale for the flower sales.
